60. Paradise (Painters') Hill

One of the most panoramic places in Sigulda, painted by grands such as J. Feders, J. Rozentāls and V. Purvītis, hence the second name of the place – Painters' Hill. This is the beginning of the trails leading towards the Vējupite ravine to explore other natural landmarks.

61. Emperor's View and Emperor's Chair

Lookout points with a striking view of the ancient Gauja River valley were created to mark the visit of Russian Tsar Alexander II to Sigulda in the second half of the 19th century. You can continue exploring nature from these locations via a network of trails leading towards the Gauja River.

62. Gūtmaņala (Gutmans cave)

The largest grotto cave in the Baltic States and the earliest tourist attraction in Latvia, the walls of which have witnessed many events and preserve inscriptions dating back to the 17th century. It is also the origin of the beautiful story of Turaida Rose, who secretly met at the cave with her beloved Viktors, the gardener of the Sigulda Castle.

63. Sigulda Devil's Cave

The rocky outcrop of the Devil's Cave is 250m long and about 15m high, forming an ancient cult site – the Devil's Cave (or the Velnāla in Latvian). It is a protected geological site, best viewed from the opposite bank of the river.

64. Inčukalns Devil's Cave

Inčukalns Devil's Cave (Velnāla) is a legendary rock that holds many secrets in its dim depths and is said to have once been the dwelling place of the devil. A visit to the cave may be combined with the 3rd section of the long-distance route "Mežtaka", which leads from Vangāži to Rāmkalni.

65. Raven Ravine and Cave

The Raven Ravine is formed in dark red Middle Devon sandstone and adjacent to it is a small triangular cave, the origin of the name of which is traced back to an old legend.

66. Peter's Cave

The visually remarkable Peter's Cave resembles a fissure-like niche in the red sandstone wall and its entrance is only 0.5 m wide.

67. Satešale Ancient Settlement Hill and Canyon

Satešale Ancient Settlement Hill or the Hill of Līvis is a witness of the earliest settlement of Sigulda, the site of fierce battles between local tribes and German knights in the 13th century. Satešale Canyon is like the hidden jewel of nature – less known, yet a charming place on the trail route with its red cliffs and sandstone ravine.

68. Raganu kalns (The witches' pot)

Raganu katls is a huge sulphurous funnel or ravine formed as a result of different water-

courses. The ravine is a partially isolated cylinder 30 m high and 20 m wide on the valley side. The inner part of the ravine resembles a geological museum panorama, displaying the folding, layering, composition, and colour changes of the rocks.

69. Pīkēne Bluff

The Pīkēne Bluff is a stretch of the right main bank of the Gauja River, about 1 km long and 70-80 m high, with small adjacent ravines. Along the walking route you will see several sandstone outcrops and a small waterfall.

70. Pedestrian Bridge over the River Gauja

Built in 1979, this footbridge over the Gauja River connects hikers on both sides of the river in a circular route and offers a picturesque view of the Velnāla cliffs.

71. Serpentine Roads

The Krimulda Serpentine Road was created in the 19th century in anticipation of the visit of Tsar Alexander II of Russia and is now a popular walking route from the Gauja Bridge to Krimulda Manor. The Sigulda Serpentine Road connects Sigulda's Festivity Square and the Gauja Bridge, letting you explore the unique landscape of the valley from a different angle.

72. Lēdurga Arboretum

A life's work of one man, Lēdurga Arboretum has grown into a favourite destination for nature lovers who appreciate the unique nature collection in every season of the year. It provides an endless source of material for arboreal researchers, as many species and varieties of arboreal plants that are considered difficult to grow in Northern Vidzeme thrive and survive winter in Lēdurga. The park is the departure and destination point for a walking route through the historic centre of the village of Lēdurga.

73. Kalkugrava (Mežmuiza) Springs

A European protected "Natura 2000" site and a geological area uncommon in Latvia. The springs flow from the Kalkugrava slope and, depending on rainfall, the number of these brooks can vary from 3 to 14.

74. Sauleskalns (Sun Hill)


Op top of the Sun Hill you will have a panoramic view of Mālpils and the water reservoirs in the centre. Here you can also see the sculptures from the 1986 sculpture symposium.

75. Tornkalns (Tower Hill)

The highest point of Mālpils rural municipality. The Devil's Tower used to be located on the hilltop towering as a place of entertainment for the local nobility, where they sipped tea and hunted animals on the forest openings down from the tower. The tower was so high that the light on the top floor misled passing vessels in the sea gulf, thus the emperor said to have ordered it to be torn down several storeys. Today, all that remains of the tower are the grass-covered foundations.

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Tourist routes

83. Mālpils Nature Trail

A linear trail along the left bank of the Merupe River running for about 3.5 km. The route passes sights such as Otto Skulme's Oak, Friendship Stone, Mālpils medieval settlement mound, Mālpils and Patriotic War Brethren cemeteries, Skulme Family Site.

84. Kubesele Nature and History Trail

Approximately 4 km long circular trail through pristine nature, accompanied by the babbling brooks of the Runtinupite River and revealing such sights as Kubesele Cave, Saulstari Rock, Big Stone, Rafter's Anchors, and others, including a travellers' cabin with an exhibition "Historical Pages of Krimulda 13th–19th Centuries".

85. Three Castles Road Sigulda–Krimulda–Turaida

The most popular one-day route to explore the ancient Gauja River valley on foot and discover the Sigulda Castle Quarter, Krimulda Manor and Castle Ruins, as well as the Turaida Museum Reserve and Castle.

86. Hold your breath! From Sigulda Castle Quarter to Vējupite Ravine

A challenging 10 km circular route for those who are not used to climbing the steep slopes of Sigulda, but it's absolutely worth it to discover truly breath-taking grandeur of nature, wild creeks, sandstone outcrops and caves in the immediate vicinity of the town. Sigulda Castle Quarter, the heart of the city, marks the start and end of the route.

87. The best panoramic lookout points of the Ancient Gauja River Valley

This 8-15 km route from Sigulda to Krimulda and back includes the most remarkable sights, landscapes, and observation spots in the area, such as the Emperor's View, Pīkēne Bluff, Devil's Cave (Velnāla) Cliffs and the bridge over the Gauja River. However, you'll need to master the steep slopes and climbs

of the Gauja valley terrain to appreciate these sights.

88. One day around Allaži

A 43 km long and scenically rich route delighting cyclists with both beautiful forests along the banks of the River Gauja Valley and nature landscapes. The route includes several uncommon or otherwise extraordinary natural sites in Latvia, such as Katlapu Rock, Ziedleju Cliffs, Ezernieki Karst Sinkholes, Černausti Stone, Černausti Oak and Kalkugrava (Mežmuiza) Springs, etc.

89. One day around More

The 43 km route for active cyclists or motorists passes through the municipality of More, historically developed from four estates in the area. The route is encircled by several hills and the Suda Swamp, adding plenty of thrill to the meandering drive and revealing culturally significant landmarks such as the Museum of the Battles of More and the Memorial Park, and deer encounters in the "More" Safari Park.

90. A river of leaves in Lēdurga

A 5 km loop route starting and ending in the Lēdurga Arboretum and including seven information stands about historical buildings in Lēdurga, such as the Garlie Merkels Lēdurga Primary School, the shop, the watermill, the church, and others.

91. Sigulda–Līgatne

This circular route is approximately 50 km long and best suited for active hikers or cyclists with views of the sandstone bedecked banks of the Gauja River, Vējupite Ravine, Daudu Waterfall and other picturesque gems of the Gauja National Park.

92. Sigulda–Rāmkalni

The approximately 30 km long circular route, perfect for active hikers or cyclists, including interesting nature sites – Ziedleju Cliffs, Katlapu Rock, Big Stone, Kubesele Nature Trail, and others.
